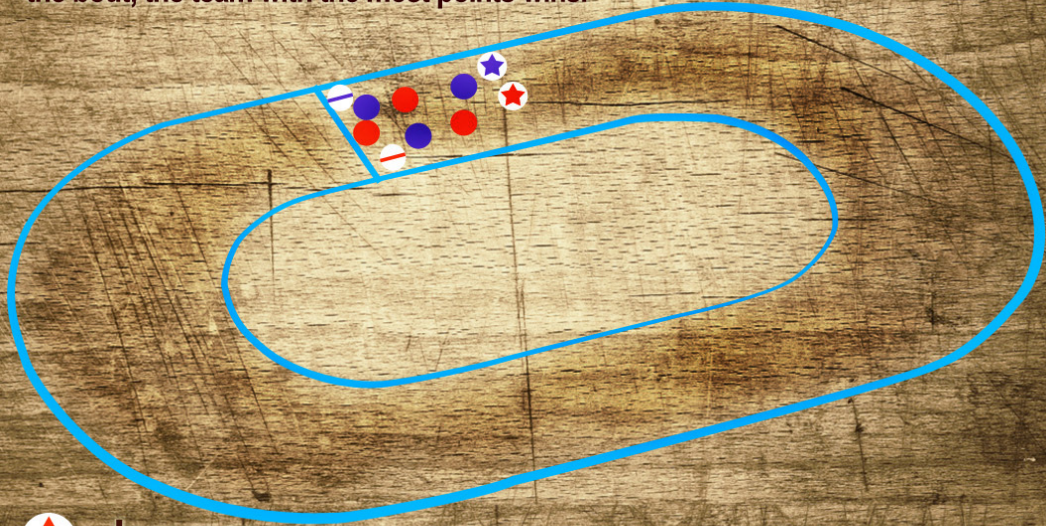


Roller Derby 101



HOW TEAMS SCORE DURING JAMS:

It's during each 90 second jam when the two teams score points. At the end of the bout, the team with the most points wins.



Jammer

Jammers must make an initial pass through the Pack before becoming eligible to score points. The Lead Jammer is whichever Jammer is physically in the lead. Once they have broken through the Pack, Lead Jammer status can change throughout a jam. During the initial pass only, Jammers knocked out of bounds must re-enter behind the Pack.

Pivot

The Pivot positions themselves on the start line. They generally control the pace of their team during each jam. If the opposing team's jammer passes them, the Pivot may break from the pack to become their team's Active Jammer.

Blocker

Blockers play offense and defense simultaneously, assisting their Jammer through the pack while preventing the opposing Jammer from getting through. Blockers line up with or behind the Pivots, in front of the Jammers.
